Welcome to a new year of AWANA Club! We are so excited to work together to bring God's Word deep into the hearts of your children.

To make this a most successful year, here are some tips for you as parents:

- 1) Make sure your child comes to Club with all they need to be able to participate in the activities. This includes their book, a Bible for Sparks on up (NKJV recommended, but other versions will do - we have some if your child needs one) and their uniform. Also make sure they are in sneakers/tennis shoes so they can participate safely in Games.
- 2) Make time at home for your child to work on the sections in the book and memorize their verses. The books are set up so that you can break up the sections into one or two questions or parts a day or have it all done at once within about 20 minutes. This is an excellent way to plan for a daily devotion, especially if you are homeschooling.
- 3) Consistency is key. If the child says the weekly verse a couple of times each day, then he or she will have a good chance to master it by the end of the week and remember it longer. Also making Club a priority each Sunday helps in book completion and learning about God and His Word.
